



Woman Entrepreneur Award

Criteria: Nominee must be a female who owns/operates a business that has functioned for at least three (3) years and generates a minimum of \$5,000 gross revenue annually. The business must make or sell a product or provide a quantifiable service. Franchise owners are not eligible for this award. WCW board members are not eligible for the award while serving on the board. The deadline for 2022 nominations is **April 30, 2022**.

Nomination:

1. Nominee may nominate herself or be nominated by another individual.
2. In addition to the name, mailing, and email addresses of the nominee, WCW requires a description of the business that includes its location and the product or service provided.
3. Please include both a summary of the nominee's education, training, background, community service/ involvement, and a picture of her at her business.
4. Signed release for the use of the picture and information on WCW media (see nomination form).
5. WCW requires a statement from the entrepreneur which details the benefits and challenges of establishing a business in Wyoming.
6. Submit this completed form along with the picture to Jennifer Wilmetti at jennifer.wilmetti@wyboards.gov. Please note that only complete applications will be considered.

Recognition: Along with recognition on WCW website and social media and statewide media outlets, the award will be provided at a recognition ceremony in the recipient's business location city.
